The free Arabic class

## 1st person (masculine & feminine)

I = أنا

We = نحنُ

# 2nd person

## Masculine

You = أَنْتَ

You (2 people) = أَنْتُمَا

You (+2) = أَنْتُمْ

## Feminine

You = أَنْتِ

You (2 people) = أَنْتُمَا

You (+2) = أَنْتَنَّ

# 3rd person

## Masculine

He = هُوَ

Them (2 people) = هُمَا

Them (+2) = هُمْ

## Feminine

She = هِيَ

Them (2 people) = هُنَّا

Them (+2) = هُنَّ

# The root system

To write

To study

دَرْسٌ

# The present tense

# The present tense (to do = فعل = فَعَلَ)

We change tashkil of the first and the last letters to sokon

فَعَلَ = فعل

And then we add the prefix or suffix that we have

Note : if we have ي as a suffix we change tashkil of ل to ل

And if we have و as a suffix we change tashkil of ل to ل

English	Romanization	Arabic
“I”	‘a–	أـ
“you” (masculine singular)	ta–	تـ
“you” (feminine singular)	ta–iina	ثـيـنـ
“he” / “it”	ya–	يـ
“she” / “it”	ta–	تـ
“we”	na–	نـ
“you” (masculine plural)	ta–uuna	تـوـنـ
“you” (feminine plural)	ta–na	ثـنـ
“they” (masculine)	ya–uuna	يـوـنـ
“they” (feminine)	ya–na	يـنـ

You do (masculine singular)	تَفْعَلُ
You do (feminine singular)	تَفْعَلِيْنَ
He / it do	يَفْعَلُ
She / it do	تَفْعَلُ

# The past tense

# The past tense (to do = فعل = فَعَلَ)

We change tashkil of the last letters to sokon

فعل = فَعَلْ

And then we add the prefix or suffix that we have

Note : if we have ي as a suffix we change tashkil of ل to ل

And if we have و as a suffix we change tashkil of ل to ل

English	Romanization	Arabic
“I”	<i>-tu</i>	تُ
“you” (masculine singular)	<i>-ta</i>	تَ
“you” (feminine singular)	<i>-ti</i>	تِ
“he” / “it”	<i>-a</i>	Put fatha ` on the last letter
“she” / “it”	<i>-at</i>	تُّ
“we”	<i>-na</i>	نَا
“you” (masculine plural)	<i>-tum</i>	تُمْ
“you” (feminine plural)	<i>-tunna</i>	تُنْ
“they” (masculine)	<i>-uu</i>	وَ
“they” (feminine)	<i>-na</i>	نَ

English	Arabic
I did	فَعَلْتُ
You did (masculine singular)	فَعَلْتَ
You did (feminine singular)	فَعَلْتِ
He / it did	فَعَلَ
She / it did	فَعَلْتْ
We did	فَعَلْنَا
You did (masculine plural)	فَعَلْلَمْ
You did (feminine plural)	فَعَلْلَنَّ
They did (masculine)	فَعَلُوا
They did (feminine)	فَعَلْنَ

# The future tense

# The future tense (to do = فعل)

We add سـ to the present tense

present tense + سـ

English	Arabic
I will do	سأَفْعَلُ
You will do (masculine singular)	سَتَفْعَلُ
You will do (feminine singular)	سَتَفْعَلِيْنَ
He / it will do	سَيَفْعَلُ
She / it will do	سَتَفْعَلُ
We will do	سَنَفْعَلُ
You will do (masculine plural)	سَتَفْعَلُوْنَ
You will do (feminine plural)	سَتَفْعَلَانَ
They will do (masculine)	سَيَفْعَلُوْنَ
They will do (feminine)	سَيَفْعَلَانَ
